The Capstone Learning Academy, powered by KinderCare Education at Work, provides education and family care solutions for UA's faculty, staff, and students. The center cares for infants starting at six weeks of age through pre-K.

Enrollment Eligibility:

Faculty, staff, and students enrolled in a minimum of 12 undergraduate hours or nine graduate hours have priority for enrolling their children.

Age Range: The academy cares for infants from six weeks of age through 5 years.

Tuition Rates:

Faculty/Staff: \$910 per month

Students: \$672 per month

Community: \$949 per month

A 10% discount is applied to the rate of each additional child.

- **Enrollment Fee:** A non-refundable enrollment fee of \$200 per faculty/staff dependent and\$100 per student dependent is due at the time of registration. The maximum enrollment fee for a family is \$250.
- **Capacity:** The academy can accommodate 250 children. Enrollment is on a first-come, first-served basis, and children will be placed on a waitlist once the spots are filled.
- **Tuition Assistance:** Capstone Learning Academy partners with the Alabama Office of Child Care Subsidy to provide the subsidized childcare opportunities through The Child Care and Development Fund (CCDF). The mission of this program is to provide Alabama's low and moderate-income families with equal access to affordable and quality childcare services as they participate in work, educational or training activities.
